BLESSING BOX MINISTRY

The Mission Team has launched a Blessing Box Ministry to support our neighbors in need. Located in the church parking lot near the entrance, the Blessing Box follows a "take what you need, leave what you can" approach, offering non-perishable food and essential items.

Initially, the box will be stocked with non-perishable food only. As the community becomes familiar with it, we plan to include hygiene and personal care items. Contents will be updated seasonally. A list of acceptable donation items is available on the table in the narthex and will be revised throughout the year.

This ministry invites participation from the entire congregation. You can contribute by donating items or volunteering to check and restock the box. Volunteers may monitor the box anytime they're at church during the week. A sign-up sheet and monitoring instructions are posted in the narthex.

Food donations can be placed in the same cart used for the Haymarket Food Bank. Items suitable for the Blessing Box will be selected from there as needed.
